### Introduction

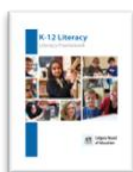

### Learning Excellence Actions

- Explicit instruction using UFLI program to improve phonological awareness and decoding text.
- Use the student assessment results to design tasks for microteaching and small group targeting instruction to address the needs of students requiring additional support in reading and number sense
- Model "Push-In" support for complex

### Well-Being Actions

- Create a school Breakout space to support students getting into a "just right" state.
- Complete school-based continuums of Supports for Well-Being.
- Use age-appropriate texts to demonstrate the range of identities and ways of being.

## School Development Plan – Data Story

### 2024-25 SDP GOAL ONE:

*Student foundational skills in literacy and mathematics will improve.*

Outcome one:

*Students will improve in phonological awareness and decoding skills*

Outcome two:

*Students' fluency in mathematics will improve through a focus on conceptual understanding.*

### Celebrations

- Literacy results from the Early Years Assessments improved in all areas ranging from 3% - 20%
- Numeracy results from Early Years Assessments also improved ranging from 5% - 9%.
- Student surveys showed improvement, 2% - 13% in identified areas of resilience, connectedness and self-regulation.

### Areas for Growth

- Build students' early literacy skills by continuing to assess and intervene as early as possible.
- Build students numeracy skills specific to the area of conceptual understanding in Math.
- Increase student feelings of representation within the diverse school community

### Next Steps

- Completion of the continuum of supports for literacy and Math through the collaborative response model.
- Model the use of Daily 5 and Daily 3 in classrooms to support diverse learning and improve task design.
- Host a school-wide Cultural Night celebrating the diversity of our students and families
